Steve Glasser,
*Strom Center for Entrepreneurship
at Dickinson State University*



The Strom Center opened at Dickinson State University in 2006 as a \$1.6 million Center of Excellence. It also received a Bush Foundation grant for Hometown Competitiveness, which includes 7 communities that have ongoing projects for their towns.

The Center hosts the Small Business Development Center and Business Challenge. It offers consulting in human resources, web design and management, and marketing. Other activities include talent initiative and out of state job fairs.

The Center collaborates with Bismarck State College for workforce training, which will include welding training, lab technician and CNA training in Dickinson. The Center is also part of a program to offer workforce development for the energy sector.

Upcoming events: Strom Conference on April 16 and a grant writing workshop on April 21 and 29.
