January is Rotary Awareness Month

Dong Kurn Lee, International Rotary President, has identified water, health and hunger, and literacy as his emphases this year. Statistics from UNICEF and the World Health Organization that point the need for Rotary's work in these areas:

- Worldwide, unsafe water and poor sanitation and hygiene kill 5,000 children under age 5 each day;
- 88% of diarrheal disease is caused by contaminated water and inadequate sanitation and hygiene;
- Globally, diarrhea kills more people than tuberculosis or malaria;
- For every US \$1 contributed to water and sanitation projects, the expected return is between \$3 and \$34.

Ben C. Frank Human Performance Center at DSU



The Ben C. Frank Human Performance Center at Dickinson State University was established in the summer of 2000 using a \$100,000 gift from Frank, a 1964 DSU graduate. The Center utilizes the Athletic Republic Acceleration Program, a program which employs a combination of training methods and technology to enhance athletic performance. Since its inception, the Center has had three primary objectives, according to Leno: provide state-of-the-art training for DSU athletes in every sport; provide DSU health and physical education students with opportunities for lab experience; and create opportunities for research and protocol and product development. Local high school athletes are able to use the center during the summer months.
