## In Memory of Lloyd Moldenhauer



Rotarian and Paul Harris Fellow **Lloyd Moldenhauer**, 85, died Jan. 18. A Rotary member since 1989, Lloyd served on the membership committee, was Jason Hanson's sponsor and was a long time member of the Vocational Awareness Committee. He was offered honorary membership in 2007. Lloyd built the shelves in the Elks store room for Rotary materials and was known for building wooden toys, with the proceeds donated to the Guatemala project. Lloyd became a Paul Harris Fellow in August 2000 and was a sustaining member. Our club donated \$100 in Lloyd's name to the Rotary Foundation. He remained active in Rotary until his death, attending his last meeting in November.
