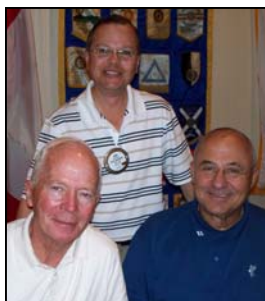

## Last Week's Speaker:

### Managing energy efficiency & tips for saving money



**Gary Peters**

Gary Peters directs two energy weatherization programs in Dickinson and Williston as part of a federal grants. Over 220 low-income homes each year receive assistance so that their heating bills are more manageable. Eleven counties in 16,000 square miles are served with two crews in 28 foot work trailers.

#### Tips to Rotarians to save energy:

- ⇒ Invest in a programmable thermostat so that you can lower the temperature when you don't need it.
- ⇒ Have your furnace cleaned.
- ⇒ Install low flow showerheads.
- ⇒ Set your water heater no higher than 120 degrees.
- ⇒ Check your home's chase ways for heat escape.
- ⇒ Install compact fluorescent light bulbs.
- ⇒ R-60 insulation level in the attic with electric heat.
