The Southwest Coalition of Safe Communities started in 1988 as the traffic safety program. Becky Byzewski has been working for 13 years as the prevention coordinator at Community Action, which is home of the Coalition that covers the 8 counties of southwest North Dakota. The Coalition works on several projects:



- Server training for liquor establishment employees.
- Driving simulator.
- 3-D Month.
- Distracted Driver Program.
- Victim impact panel for drunk driving offenders.
- Monthly child car seat safety checks.
- Seat Belt Convincer.
- Safe Routes to School for kids walking & biking.
- Safety City Program, this year for 98 children.
- Project ACE and the upcoming June 11 conference.
- Data collection and behavior surveys of students in grades 6-12.
