Last Week: Badlands Activity Center

"Volunteers for Progress," represented by Diana Knutson and Scott Karsky, gave information about the Badlands Activity Center, which will replace the aging Whitney Stadium at Dickinson State University. The project is on the Nov. 4 Dickinson city election ballot, with a request of \$6 million from city sales tax & hospitality tax revenue to assist the \$16 million project. DSU projects starting construction in December with field and bleachers ready for the fall of 2009. Completion of the entire project is expected by January 2010.
