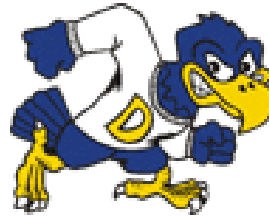

Sr. Dorothy Zeller, Dickinson Catholic Schools Superintendent, and John Heinen, Development Director, said the school system considers its role as one of a partnership first with the parents the main educators of children.
