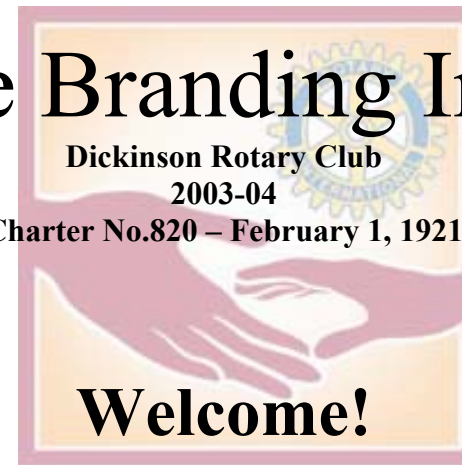

Tomorrow is the anniversary of the tragedy of 9-11. I bring it up reluctantly because it conjures up uncomfortable feelings of insecurity, unsettledness and loss. I started to get sick of seeing those towers fall again on TV as some of the networks do varies types of stories on it. PBS offered several documentaries on "Why the Towers Fell" and on families moving on and so forth. The towers fell because huge airliners were smashed into them, good enough reason for me. But it is good someone cares, they can work on the next designs to prevent this in the future. Meanwhile the bad guys are working on worse ways to inflict pain. It is good to remember. It is good to remember that these types of things *do* happen, that there *are* bad guys out there, and that people *do* hate us. It is necessary to remember our feelings that day and how we were going to get justice no matter what. Then we have to compare them to our feelings now. Have we become complacent two years later?
