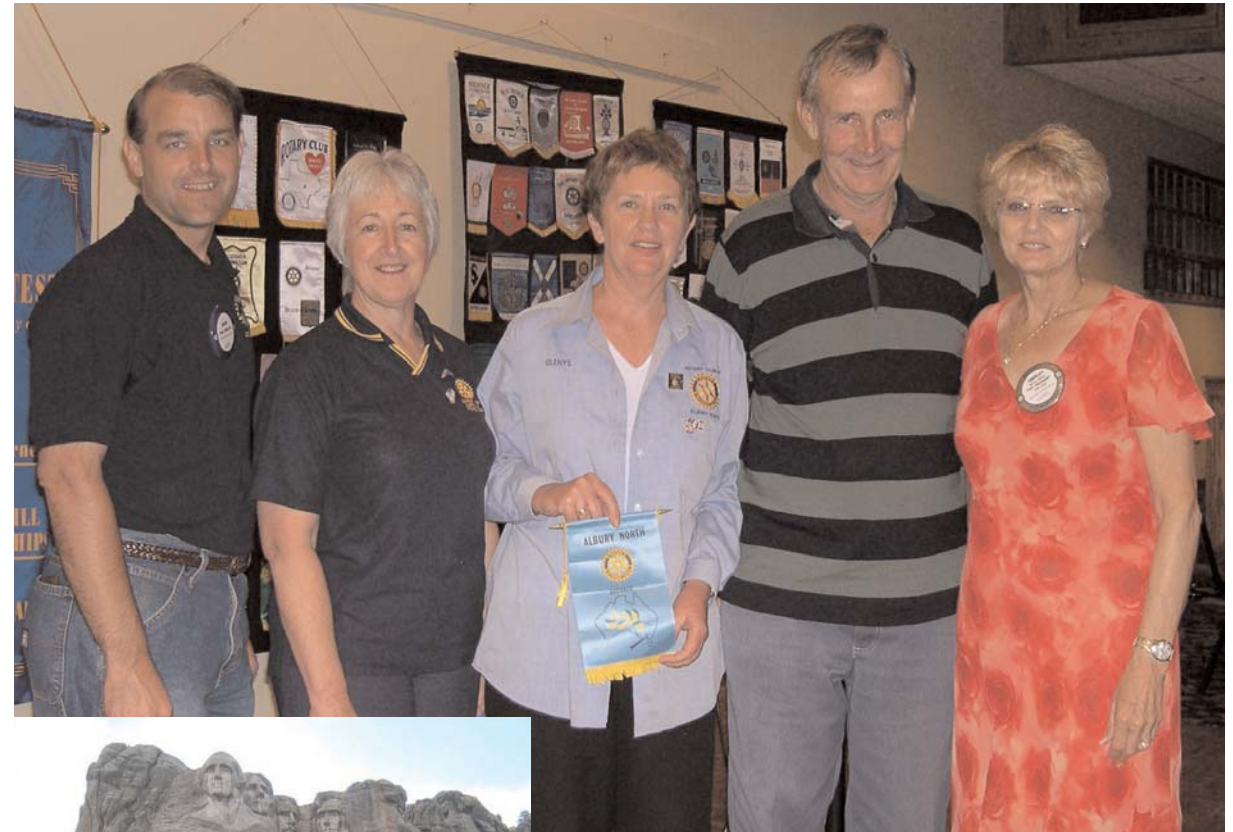
He also encouraged members to again sign-up in their area of interest. Everyone will be asked to serve on a committee.
