Kevin Klipfel, facilities manager for Dickinson Parks and Recreation was at the Rotary meeting on the 17th to share information on the West River Community Center. After a year in the building, the renewal rate for the facility stands at 92 percent.

After just a little over a year, a 20,000 square foot extension is in the works, which will house 3 tennis courts, 4 golf stalls and three offices, plus storage and a maintenance area.

Greg Sund said plans are to add 40 acres to the west for further expansion.
