Michelle Wall, certified trainer, with Eide Bailly Dale Carnegie was the featured speaker Aug. 24.



She shared a couple stories of unusual heroes, including a story of Easy Eddy, Al Capone's lawyer. He wanted his son to have a better life than he had ... He changed his life, turned in Capone, was killed for his action ... but ...

His son, who died at 29, serving his country, has an airport named after him ...

his name Butch O'Hare ... O'Hare airport. She went on th talk about what makes people successful. Out of knowledge, skill and attitude. Knowledge is a mere 15 percent, which leaves skill and attitude at 85 percent.

Everyone in attendance received a small Dale Carnegie Golden Book.

A full Dale Carnegie course will be here in Dickinson, starting Sept. 22 and running until Dec. 15. The class meets for 3.5 hours for 12 weeks -- 5:30 to 9 p.m. Thursdays.
