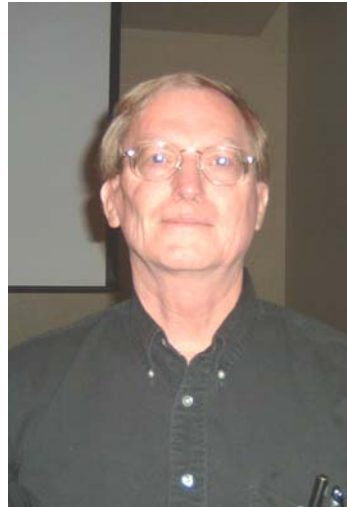
What is Rotary?

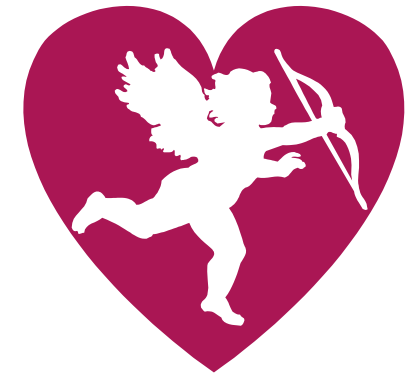
