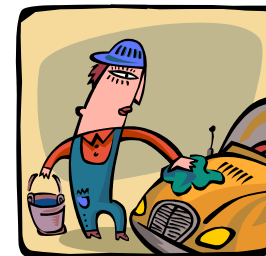
Guests Last Week
