in at the new Community Center. It offers a safe and chemical free alternative to seniors who are celebrating graduation. See Dale Jacobsen for more details.

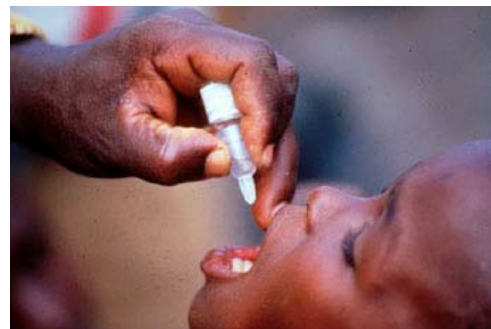
**Braggs and Fines**
