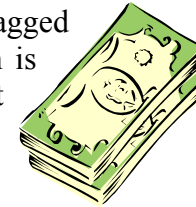

Last week Greg Sund bragged that his daughter Elizabeth is one of the commencement speakers for Dickinson High School!

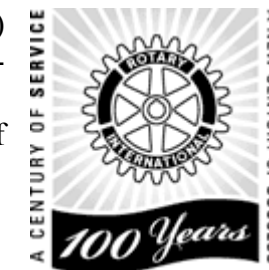
