Bob Weir let us know that he received an email from our former exchange student from Japan, Agie, who wanted us to know that he graduated from the University of Oregon.

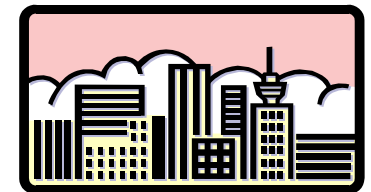
Clyde Frank fined himself \$1 because he bragged about our club to the District Governor.
